NURSE'S NOTES

Flu shots will be offered on November 6 at HLV from 3:30-6:00. These will be offered by the Poweshiek county Health Dept. Details will follow later.

The following items need to be taken care of before school starts! All health forms are available on the HLV website under the Quick Access drop box under Student Health.

Preschool & Kindergarten- follow your packet information and turn in at registration.

3rd grade-vision screening needs done and turned in at registration

7th grade-Dtap and Meningococcal vaccine needs done and an updated immunization certificate should be turned in at registration

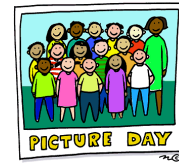
9th grade-dental screening needs completed and turned in at registration (any exam since Sept. 2016 qualifies)

12th grade-Meningococcal vaccine received and an update immunization record needs turned in at registration

Athletes-If you are going to be participating in any sports in the upcoming year, an athletic physical is required. Parents must sign the form before it is turned in. A concussion form also needs filled out every year.

*****Meningococcal vaccine***** This is a new law for both 7th and 12 grade students. The state will NOT be granting any exemptions so this must be completed prior to the start of the school year!

The following new policy was submitted by Cathy Verdeck.

HLV COMMUNITY SCHOOL

As of _____, your family lunch account balance is \$ _____,

Please send payment immediately with your child or pay online.

HLV Community School District policy for the family lunch account is as follows:

“Family members will be allowed a \$15.00 maximum charging limit. When the charging limit is met students will be notified in the line that they will be unable to eat by charging to the family account. They may, however, pay cash to eat.” Automatic email notifications go out daily if you have a low balance and if we are provided with your email address. Also elementary students are sent home low balance notices in their Wednesday envelopes and students in 6-12 receive daily receipts if their balance is low at the end of the serving line

If your family receives free meals, your child(ren) can continue to purchase full meals but will not be allowed to purchase any extras until the account has a positive balance. If you pay full price or reduced price for meals, your child(ren) will not be allowed to charge anything to the family account until it has a positive balance. The family may send cash on a daily basis or bring a sack lunch until the account is paid in full.

Elementary students receive milk or juice in the classroom as an extra at a cost of \$.35 per carton; this includes all free, reduced, and full paying students. If your family receives free meals you will need to keep money in the family lunch account for this. We will continue the practice of NO MILK/JUICE in the classrooms if you have a ZERO balance.

The following are a cost of a daily purchase: Breakfast \$1.95, Lunch \$2.75/\$2.80. Adult price is \$3.80. Reduced Breakfast \$.30, Reduced Lunch \$.40, Milk/Juice \$.35, Ala Carte are \$.25 to \$2.00.

You may check your account balance or pay online by going to www.hlv.k12.ia.us. Under Food Service click on Lunch Account. You will need your account number and password. If you don't know these contact Cathy Verdeck at cverdeck@hlv.k12.ia.us or call 319-647-2161 ext. 105.

Just a reminder that applications for free and reduced meals are available in the office or from Cathy Verdeck at any time during the year. If you think you may qualify or if your financial situation changes during the school year please stop by and pick up an application or contact Cathy Verdeck and one will be mailed to you.
