Old Business

- 1) **Business Memberships:** Laurel hopes to get all of them done this week.
- 2) **Pizza Ranch Fundraiser:** Beau talked to the Pizza Ranch people about the fundraiser. They said to avoid Tuesday nights (kids eat free) and it is slow on Mondays. Since Wed. is Church night, Thursday is all that is left available. Our preferred date was decided to be March 9. Laurel will call to check on that date. We will need 3-4 kids and at least 2 adults per shift. Shifts start at 5 pm.
- 3) **Youth Basketball Tournament Report:** There was a really good turnout for both tournaments. We made \$1400 for girls entries and \$1500 for boys entries. Girls brought in \$1208 at the gate and boys brought in \$1370. For concessions, girls brought in \$2231 and boys \$2176.50. The totals (before expenses) for girls was \$4839 and boys \$5046.50 for a grand total of \$9889.50. Medals were approximately \$354, so a profit of \$9379 (expenses for concessions was unknown). Rhonda reported there was a total of 330 volunteer hours for the girls tournament and 318.25 volunteer hours for the boys. Dates were discussed for the 2018 tournaments and setting them now to make sure we can get our dates out earlier. After checking the calendar, the dates were set for January 20th and 27th as long as there were no boys JV tournaments those weekends.
- 4) **AAU Volleyball from 1/29:** Only 4 teams were in attendance. The gate for the day was \$114 and the concessions brought in \$280.
- 5) **AAU Volleyball 2/5:** There will be 10 teams this weekend, but only 1 age group will be a qualifying tournament due to number of teams participating.
- 6) **Scholarship Revision:** The committee needs to get a copy of last year's application from Karla R. and then will revise requirements and questions.

New Business

- 1) **Winter Sports Concessions:** The game on Friday is filled and there are only 2 more games next week. The girls crossover game has been moved to 7:00 (no JV).
- 2) **Winter Banquet:** The date will be set after the season is over. Booster Club will once again provide the main dish.
- 3) **Fish Fry:** This year we will offer a choice of 2 types of fish (Pollock or Catfish) or chicken strips. Sides will be Mac and Cheese, cole slaw, yeast roll, dessert and drink for \$10 (\$7 for kids 12 and under). Booster Club has 1 fryer and will need 2 more. Beau reminded us to put cardboard underneath the fryers to keep the grease from off the sidewalk. Rhonda will make a poster and it can go on the cable channel and in the Warrior Tribune. We will serve 4-7 pm on March 3.
- 4) **Additional Fundraisers?:** Brian brought up the idea of a T-ball tournament. We are in a new league for summer rec and the tournament is in the middle of the season instead of the end, so we could possibly do one at the end of the season. Drive One for Your School will probably not be coming back to our school through Thys, but we can look into other dealerships to see if they do something similar.

AD Report

- 1) **Track items:** Track uniforms are in. Kevin brought samples to show off. The PO for the blocks will be put in tomorrow. Kevin reported there are 6 boys and 6 girls signed up for the track camp at U of I. The total cost was \$962, so the \$500 camp funds for boys track and \$500 for girls track will cover the cost. If the athlete chose to participate in the second session, they were informed they would have to pay the fee themselves. The dates for those camps are Feb. 19 and Mar. 5.
- 2) **Baseball/Softball:** Beau said that orders for baseball/softball bats need to go in soon. We looked up the total given from last year and it was shown that we donated \$1000 each for baseball and softball (including JH). Kevin made a motion to match that amount this year. Patty 2nd. Motion approved. Beau also said that Coach Warwick would like to do some additional fundraising for other things for baseball. There is also a new batting cage coming that can stay up outside all winter.
- 3) **JH Boys Basketball:** Beau reported that there were not enough basketball jerseys for the JH boys basketball team this year and he had to order some at the last minute with pre-approval by Laurel. The total was less than \$800. Kevin made a motion to cover those expenses and Rhonda 2nd. Motion approved.
