\*Seniors will meet during Success Center on Tuesday, May 7th in the computer lab to go over graduation items.

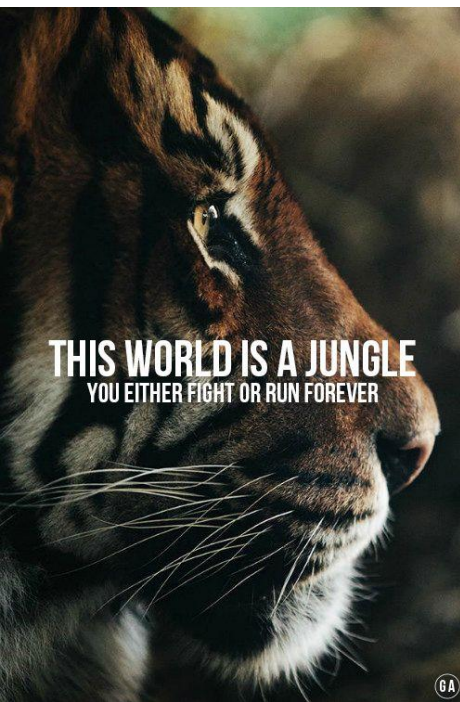
\*Seniors will have locker clean out during Success Center on Thursday, May 9th.
