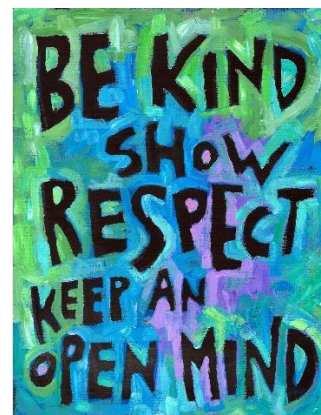
JAZZ CHOIR: rehearsal this week will be everyone on Thursday at 7 am in the choir room
