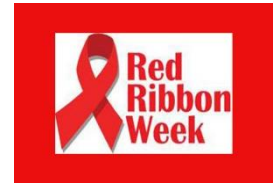

WARRIOR WRESTLING: There is a sign-up sheet in the office if you are interested.

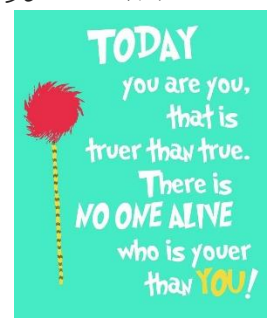
