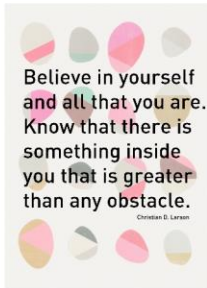

The Tippie Gateway Program is intended for **high school juniors**. The program is in the summer between the students junior and senior year. Preference will be given to applicants from populations under-represented in business including minority, low-income, and/or first-generation. We will select 45 students to participate in this scholarship-funded program. The only cost for participants is their travel to and from campus.

Program highlights:

- Six-day, residential program: Sunday June 24 through Friday June 29, 2018
- No cost to the students; housing, meals, and other expense are covered by scholarships
- Learn about the various business majors: Business Analytics, Finance, Marketing, Accounting, Management, Economics etc
- Interactive workshops focused on their strengths as students and leaders
- Participate in a case study competition
- Interact with students, faculty, staff and alumni of the Tippie College of Business
