SENIORS: You may pick up your cap & gown in the office: Mandi Niemeyer, Mitchell Thys, Alannah Walker, Ben Wolf.

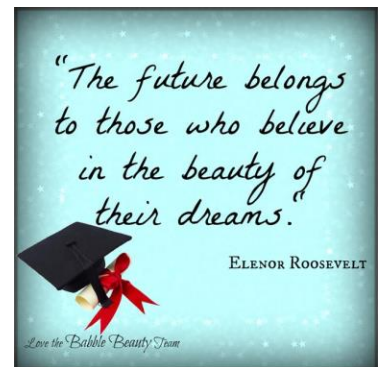
LOCKER SIGN UP: CURRENT 8th, 9th & 10th (only about 4 of you will need to share) sign up for your locker partner for next school year in the office...
