Workplace Learning Connection works in partnership with your school district to provide career exploration experiences at no cost to you!

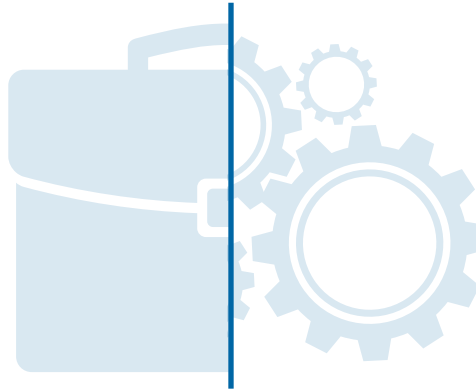
## Participate in:

### JOB SHADOW

**Choose a career and spend part of a day in a small group or one-on-one with a career professional to learn more.**

\*Juniors and seniors can apply for one job shadow per year in late August/early September.

(Check with your school to see if sophomores are eligible)



### INTERNSHIP

**Receive between 45 and 90 hours of professional career experience at a local business. This is a great avenue to scholarship awards and future jobs!**

\*Available to students the summer before junior year through the spring of senior year.
